

It combines picturesque nature and soothing sounds of flowing water. On the other hand, it allows plenty of fun activities: snorkeling, hiking, swimming, tubing, and picnicking.

Don't miss out on taking a dip in the crystal-clear waters of the springs, surrounded by astonishing natural beauty. The water temperature is 72-degrees, year-round, and the average depth is from 10 to 18 feet.

Besides swimming, in the Rainbow Springs State Park you can rent a canoe or even tube down the Rainbow River.

The Rainbow River is an aquatic preserve, and the park is a perfect area for bird watching. So you may see fish and turtles here, and also owls, hawks, and woodpeckers. Fun fact: mammoth fossils were found in the Rainbow River.

Tubing rentals are available from May to September, and the tubing trip is four hours long. Canoe, kayak, and paddleboard rentals are available all year.

Whether you choose the tube or the kayak, going down the Rainbow River will be an unforgettable experience. Scuba diving is also a great option.

This underground cave has an opening, allowing light to shine through and create a scene straight from a video game.

It is located in Williston, Florida. It was home to many extinct animal fossils, which are now in The University of Florida's Museum of Natural History.

Here you can get an awesome shot of yourself snorkeling in a pretty mysterious setting.

This place truly is a gem and a unique diving spot. If you're a certified scuba diver, you can dive deeper in the Devil's Den prehistoric spring.

The water temperature is 72 degrees, and the maximum depth is 54 ft. You can rent both scuba diving and snorkeling equipment.

If you're interested in snorkeling, make sure to make a reservation. With it, you'll get 90 minutes to spend in the Den, but you'll have to exit by 5 p.m.

Keep in mind that children under 6 aren't allowed in. Minors must have their legal guardian present (or a chaperone with a parent consent form).

For diving, you must have an Open Water Certification or Above, and a dive buddy.

This man-made, 3,657-acre lake is beloved among fishermen. Here you can try your luck to catch catfish, black crappie, largemouth bass, bluegill and redear sunfish.

It's popular as a bass fishing lake - 90 bass over 10 pounds were caught and released here in recent times. Fishing is good year-round on Lake Rousseau.
